II. Equity council 24/25 SY goals

A. Equity Council key goals at TMEMS for the 2024-2025 school year

1. Student Attendance

 What are the barriers that stand in the way of attendance? How can the school support the community?

2. Community Input and Community Collaboration

- Weekly communication to parents about events and resources in Friday newsletter
- Community stakeholders and parents have been surveyed to get feedback on multiple things this year
- How can we better support students with disabilities and their families? What information is needed?
 - (1) We would like to offer a welcome packet of all of the resources TMEMS offers to support students with disabilities once a child is identified.

III. TMEMS expansion

A. Community input

- Reached out to parents and community stakeholders to get feedback on the calendar for the 2025-2026 school year
 - Last year parents asked for no half days this year, the school responded and eliminated those
- 2. Reached out to parents and community stakeholders to get feedback on name change
 - New Name (effective 2025-2026 school year):

(1) The Montessori Academy

- 3. New Building purchase
 - Lease-purchase agreement
 - 13 classrooms
 - Room to bring in lunches- which is a top priority
 - Question if the new campus will be the middle school/high school
 - Needs a transformer, which might be a hang-up to get in by Aug 1
 - Carmel campus will become a free pre-K eventually
 - Discussion about transportation between campuses
 - We have hired a full-time bus driver for our field trips, hoping they can be utilized for the two campuses
 - Plan to keep graduating class 40-50 large, staying community focused
 - A grant has been applied for 1.5 million dollars, hope to know if we will get the grant by next month

B. Next year

- Move the middle school to our new location, start adding high school the year after
- 2. Lunches!!! We are working with other schools and vendors to incorporate a lunch program at all campuses next year.

 - Maybe the website can include some links to the materials
- 8. Parking lot is hard for pickup
 - Trying to get a light or speed lights for our school
 - Engineers have come out to see traffic patterns
 - We've discussed extending our drive
- 9. Question from parent- what does the middle school class size look like? Cap out at about 50 per grade, 25 per class
